The PEFC label guarantees that forest will be around for generations to come.

PEFC is an international non-profit, non-governmental organisation dedicated to promoting Sustainable Forest Management through independent, third-party certification. Through PEFC, certification materials can be tracked from the forests, down the supply chain to the final products, like consumer packaging or wooden pallets or in construction projects. This tracking process is called PEFC Chain of Custody certification. Beyond ensuring that the material comes from a PEFC-certified forest, the certification also protects the rights of workers in the supply chain.

THE PEFC LABEL GUARANTEES:

- ✓ Prevention of deforestation;
- ✓ Maintenance and improvement of biodiversity;
- ✓ Protection of ecological valuable areas;
- ✓ Indigenous people's rights are protected;
- ✓ Protection of the rights and well-being of people working in the forest and value chain;
- ✓ Employment for local people;
- ✓ Forests act as a carbon sink helping to mitigate climate change.

The PEFC label provides assurances to businesses and consumers that the wood, paper and packaging products on which it appears, come from responsibly managed forests.
